Where all answers are in German: Award half marks only if manipulation of relevant information is attempted. Evidence needed that candidates have understood the text.

Question 1 (21 marks (a) 9, (b) 6; (c) 6)

1. (a) *What does Janna-Berta see from the classroom window? Give **three** details (lines 1 – 11)*
Any THREE: 9 marks: 3, 3, 3 marks.

1. It was windy
2. Trees **(2)** in the school yard **(1)**
3. Flowers **(2)** in flower pots **(1)**
4. The sun **(2)** is shining **(1)**
5. It's a beautiful day
6. A man/ dog
7. The caretaker **(1)** mowing the grass **(2)**

- (b) *Janna-Berta learns Latin. Which problems does she have with it? Give **three** details.*

Any THREE: 6 marks: 2, 2, 2

(lines 15-24)

1. She is good at everything else
2. She can't understand the grammar
3. The verbs are difficult
4. She prefers English/English is spoken everywhere/all over the world
5. Nobody speaks Latin
6. It's boring
7. It's compulsory

- (c) *Describe the Latin teacher Herr Benzig. Give details (lines 24-31)*

Any THREE: 6 marks: 2, 2, 2

1. He's over **(1)** 60 **(1)**
2. He wears glasses
3. He has grey hair
4. He looks/is strict
5. He's the oldest teacher in the school
6. He gets angry when Janna-Berta hasn't done her homework

Question 2 (18 marks (a) 6; (b) 6; (c) 6)

2. (a) *Describe what happened after the nuclear accident alarm went off in the school.*
(lines 39-48)

Any THREE: 6 marks: 2, 2, 2

1. Elmar said “that’s the ABC alarm.”
2. The principal spoke over the intercom
3. Classes finish/sent home.
4. All students go home/ head for the door/ run to the exit.
5. Janna-Berta is delighted/thinks it’s her lucky day.
6. Janna-Berta packs her bag.
7. There is a lot of noise on the corridor.
8. There is chaos / panic.
9. Some students want to go to the office/to ring their parents.

- (b) *What does the reader find out about Janna- Berta’s family? Give **three** details (lines 49-63)*

Any THREE: 6 marks: 2, 2, 2

1. She has a little/nine year old brother.
2. He is in primary school
3. She has an older brother.
4. The family/Janna Berta lives in Schlitz.
5. Her father is a doctor.
6. Her parents are not at home
7. Her father is at a conference/in Schweinfurt.
8. Her mother is gone to see the grandparents.
9. Janna-Berta and Uli/her small brother are alone at home.
10. Janna Berta has to look after her little brother.
11. Their parents will come back the next day.

- (c) *What does Janna-Berta see on her way home? Give **three** details (lines 83-88)*

Any THREE: 6 marks: 2, 2, 2

1. There are many cars on the road/motorway
2. All the cars are heading to the motorway
3. People are carrying suitcases/bags to the cars.
4. A woman with two children (**1**) is running along the road (**1**).
5. The woman carries one child.
6. The other one walks behind her.
7. A man closes/locks his front door.
8. Fear on people’s faces.
9. There is panic.

Question 3 (16 marks: 2 marks per heading, 2 marks for correct translation / explanation)
